## RULES & REGULATIONS

### COVID-19 Safe Management Measures

- All participating players will need to complete the Safe Entry check-in at least 20 minutes before your scheduled game time and have your temperature checked at the entrance of Singapore Basketball Centre before they are allowed to enter.
- Only registered players are allowed to enter the sports hall, and only 20 minutes before their scheduled game time. All other team personnel not playing will be denied entry.
- All participating players will be subjected to identification checks before they enter the sports hall.
- For those not involved in the match, please maintain safe distancing and keep your mask on.
- Teams are to leave the sports hall immediately after the end of their game.

### Live Streaming

This competition will be streamed online, and by participating, you agree to allow your photographs and video recordings to be used on all relevant media platforms for publicity.

### Participating Team's Entitlement

Each participating team will receive a \$60 Rigorer voucher and reversible jerseys for each player before the team's first game. The jerseys are to be worn during all the team's games.

### Competition Period

The competition will be scheduled for the following dates:

- Saturday, 8 May 2021
- Sunday, 9 May 2021
- Saturday, 15 May 2021
- Sunday, 16 May 2021

Additional dates may be added to the following weekends if necessary. The confirmed dates will be finalized at the end of registration.

### Categories

The following categories will be organized:

- Men's Open
- Women's Open

### Competition Venue

The competition will be held at Singapore Basketball Centre, 601 Aljunied Avenue 1, #01-04, Singapore 389862.

### Team Composition

Each team shall consist of 4 players, one of whom shall be the team captain.

### Entry Fees

Entry fee shall be \$100 per team. Fees paid are non-refundable.

**Registration Period**

Registration shall begin on 31 March 2021 and end on 21 April 2021, 5pm. Submissions after the deadline may be rejected.

Should there be insufficient teams to start the event, the teams that registered will be informed and their entry fees will be refunded.

**Entry Procedure**

All players must be registered in <https://play.fiba3x3.com> with a confirmed account. Only players registered with a confirmed account are eligible to play.

The following items must be submitted when making an entry. Teams will only have their place confirmed after all the required items below are submitted.

- Completed entry form – <https://forms.gle/9SnNTmyBmMJtKoJ8>
- Proof of verified FIBA 3x3 account
- Payment of entry fee
- Signed parent's consent forms (for players under 18 years old)

All entries must be submitted by the deadline.

**Player Eligibility**

Only registered players with a valid FIBA 3x3 account are eligible to play.

The organizers reserve the right to request identification from players at any time during the competition.

**Competition Draw**

Teams will be drawn into their respective pools based on the team's FIBA 3x3 ranking points. Team ranking points are the sum of the ranking points of the team's three highest ranked players.

If there are insufficient teams with ranking points at the close of registration, the pools will be drawn randomly. The teams with ranking points will be seeded accordingly. The competition schedule will be emailed to all team captains 3 days before the start of the competition.

**Competition Format**

The competition will be played with a pool phase (minimum of 2 games) followed by single elimination knockout.

**Awards**

Medals will be awarded to the top three teams.

Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three teams:

- Champion - \$1,000
- Runner-Up - \$600
- Third - \$400

The cash prizes stated is subject to there being at least 20 teams in each category. Cash prizes will be scaled down if there are less than 20 teams in the category.

**Playing Uniforms**

Participating players are required to wear the official game's reversible jerseys provided at all games throughout this tournament.

Players who fail to comply with the dress code will not be allowed to participate in the games.

**Coaching Restrictions**

No coach may be present on the playing courts and no coaching is allowed (remotely from the bleachers or otherwise).

**Game Times**

The competition schedule handed out by the organizers is effective through only the competition's first game. Unless otherwise communicated by the organizers, following the competition's first game, each team is required to check the master scoreboard for all official schedules, times, courts, revisions, and general game information.

Teams must be ready to begin play at their scheduled start time. Teams are encouraged to remain in contact with their court to observe the effects of scheduling changes that could affect the timing of their games.

**Rules of the Game**

The competition will be officiated in accordance with the official FIBA 3x3 Rules of the Game.

Decisions made by the referees are final, and are not subject to review by video or other recordings, or other sources. The referees shall have the power to make decisions on any points not specifically covered in the official 3x3 Rules of the Game and to interpret the intent and purpose thereof.

**Competition Administration**

Any questions or disputes will be discussed only with the team captain. All disputes which do not fall under the authority of the referees must be brought to the attention of the organizers as soon as the incident in question has happened. Disputes will not be heard after the competition has been completed.

**Other Rules**

BAS reserves the rights to make changes, to add, delete and/or vary the said rules at any time as it considers necessary.

In the event of any questions or matters arising out of any point, which is not expressly provided for in any of the rules governing the competition, the decision of BAS shall be final.

**Organizer's Disclaimer**

You participate in the competition at your own risk and will take all reasonable measures to protect yourself from the risks of participation. You are responsible for all property you bring into the competition.
