

National Skills Challenge 2021

1 GENERAL

- 1.1 The Preliminaries for the BAS National Skills Challenge shall take place on 11 and 12 December 2021 from 9am to 7pm. The Finals shall take place on either 18 or 19 December 2021 (date and time to be confirmed).
- 1.2 This competition will be held at Singapore Basketball Centre, 601 Aljunied Avenue 1, #01-04, Singapore 389862.
- 1.3 This document shall govern all operational aspects of the competition.
- 1.4 BAS has the rights to make changes, add, or delete the rules in this document as it considers necessary.
- 1.5 In the event of any point not expressly provided for in the rules of the competitions, the decision of BAS shall be final.

2 SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES (SMM)

- 2.1 All participating players must be fully vaccinated under Singapore's COVID-19 vaccination programme. All persons entering the sports hall for the competition will have their vaccination checked, and only fully vaccinated registered participants are allowed entry into the sports hall.
- 2.2 An individual is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after he or she has received two doses of Pfizer-BioNTech/ Comirnaty, Moderna, or any WHO EUL vaccines.
- 2.3 Unvaccinated individuals with a valid negative result on a Pre-Event Test taken within the past 24 hours at an MOH-approved medical service provider before the expected end of the event, or recovered COVID-19 individuals within the last 270 days may also participate in the group of fully vaccinated individuals.
- 2.4 All persons entering the sports hall shall have their face mask on. Mask may be taken off only during the individual's warm up and also during the individual's turn to perform the Skills Challenge, following which the mask is to be worn after.
- 2.5 The physical distancing between each individual in their team of two (2) persons shall be 2-metres. The physical distancing between the teams shall be 3-metres apart and all times, and no intermingling is allowed.

3 TEAMS

- 3.1 An unlimited number of teams may participate in the Preliminaries of the BAS National Skills Challenge.
- 3.2 The top eight (8) teams from the Preliminaries will qualify for the Finals.
- 3.3 A team shall consist of two (2) players.

- 3.4 The minimum age for participating in the Skills Challenge is 13 years old and above (born in 2008 or before).
- 3.5 There are no gender or nationality restrictions for the composition of team members.

4 **REGISTRATION**

- 4.1 Teams are to submit their registration by no later than 30 November 2021.
- 4.2 Each participating team shall complete and send the necessary documentation to BAS, in accordance with the deadline set out in this document in order for its team to be duly registered.
- 4.3 Registration fee shall be \$30 per team.
- 4.4 Participating teams shall submit the completed online registration form and payment of registration fee to confirm their place in the competition.
- 4.5 BAS has the right not to admit to the competition a team with incomplete submission as required or submissions after the deadline.

5 COMPETITION SYSTEM

5.1 <u>Timeslot</u>

5.2 After receiving confirmation on the number of participating teams, BAS shall determine the timeslot of each team for the Preliminaries. The participating teams will be informed accordingly.

5.3 <u>Format</u>

- 5.4 Each team will be given five (5) minutes to warm up and try the stations.
- 5.5 Each team will have one (1) attempt in the BAS National Skills Challenge.
- 5.6 The scores of each team will be updated on a leaderboard.
- 5.7 The top eight (8) teams from the Preliminaries will qualify for the Finals. The qualified teams will be informed on the dates and times accordingly.
 - 5.8 Scoring
- 5.9 The score for each player shall be calculated by subtracting the total number of points scored in the stations with the total time taken to finish the stations. (Example: Player A completed the stations in 100 seconds. Player A scored a total of 10 points in the stations. Player A shall have a score of 90.
- 5.10 The scores for each team shall be calculated by adding the scores for both players in the team.

5.11 Classification of Teams

- 5.12 Teams shall be classified according to their scores.
- 5.13 The higher ranked team shall be the team with the lower team score.
- 5.14 In the event of a tie in the overall score between two (2) or more teams, the following classification rules apply:

- The higher ranked team shall be the team that scored the higher number of points from the stations.
- If both teams scored the same number of points from the stations, the higher ranked team shall be the team with the individual that had the best score (time taken by the individual player minus the points scored by the individual in each station).

6 PRIZES

- 6.1 Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) teams:
 - 1st \$500
 - 2nd \$300
 - 3rd \$200
- 6.2 Cash prizes will be awarded for the following special awards:
 - Top Performing Individual (1st) \$350
 - Top Performing Individual (2nd) \$200
 - Top Performing Individual (3rd) \$150
 - Top Performing Female \$300
 - Top Performing Male (16U) \$125
 - Top Performing Female (16U) \$125
 - Top Performing Male (14U) \$125
 - Top Performing Female (14U) \$125

*16U - players born in 2005 or after; 14U - players born in 2007 or after

7 EQUIPMENT

7.1 Molten's FIBA 3x3 basketballs shall be used for the BAS National Skills Challenge.

8 DATA

- 8.1 By participating in this competition, the players agree to BAS's use of their personal data in the registration forms and images during the course of competition for future publicity.
- 8.2 In any event, all personal data shall only be used for the purposes of organizing and monitoring of the competition.





Station 1: Speed dribble to center court. One foot must touch the half-court line




Station 2: Weave through the cones and do a layup from the right side







Station 5: Grab the rebound and dribble to the spot in blue for a shot




Station 6: Move to the spot in blue and wait for the pass before taking a shot








Station 8: Move to the spot in blue and wait for the pass before taking a shot




Station 9: Move to the spot in blue and wait for the pass before taking a shot








Station 10: Move to the spot in blue and wait for the pass before taking a shot




Station 12: Move to the spot in blue and wait for the pass before taking a shot








Station 15: P1 will move to get the rebound and pass to P2 to complete the lap


